Campers will learn and use the actors' tools of mind, body, and voice to create characters and scenes, and experience the journey from script to stage, taking part in rehearsals and a showcase performance for parents during the final class at the end of the week! Through acting exercises, improvisation, movement and voice work, and short scripts, campers will use their actors' tools to bring a performance to life!
